

Q2 Roller Implementation in Medical ICU: A Quality Improvement Project





Background

- •September 2022, Medical ICU was responsible for 32% Hospital Acquired Pressure Injuries (HAPIs) for Covenant Medical Center
- •The cost of a single HAPI is estimated to be \$14,506 (Agency for healthcare research and quality, 2017)
- •Q2 Rollers are a patient repositioning system which allows turning and repositioning of patients through an air system (HoverTech international, 2023)

Actions Taken

- •Collaboration between Nursing and Central Supply for availability of Q2 Roller
- •Established standard to use Q2 Rollers
- •Education provided to Medical ICU staff
- •Coordinated with Central Supply to order Q2 Roller
- •Q2 rollers used on intubated and patients over 250lbs
- •In-person in-services provided by HoverTech product representatives and Safe Patient Handling Coordinator
- •Nursing increased ability to turn patients regardless of staff availability



Results

The incidence of Stage 3, Stage 4, and Unstageable HAPIs decreased in Medical ICU post implementation
By August 2023, Medical ICU reported zero Stage 2, Stage 3,

Stage 4, and Unstageable HAPIs

Conclusion

•Plans for sustainability include staff feedback and re-education and opportunity to evaluate the change
