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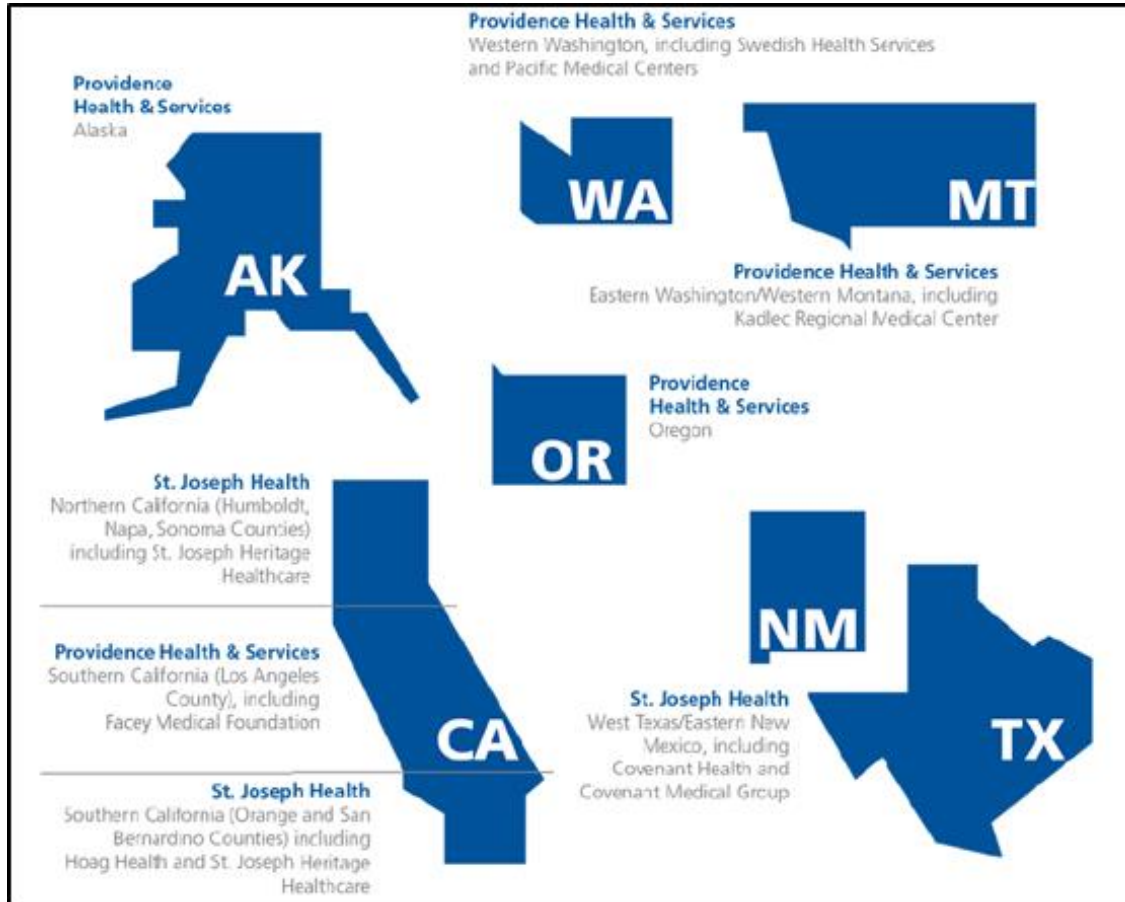

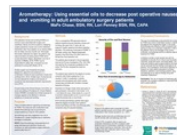

# Challenges for a Repository in a Health System

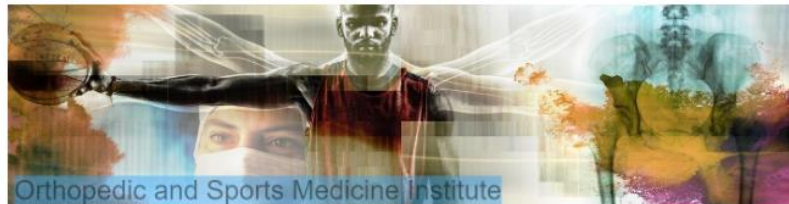
- Difficulties in outreach within a complex, dispersed organization
