

### Methods

• Find Good Catches Stories • Use HRO 3-part format • Edit, Publish, and Share using Microsoft Apps • Connect stories to HRO

## Results

- •83% increase in Near Miss/Good Catch reporting
- 2022 Caregiver Experience Survey - "I am encouraged to report patient safety concerns." 92% (RMH) 82% (SJHE)





### Discussion

- Videos don't replace leadership involvement
- Videos support HRO Engagement and Coaching
- More research needed

- Cost-Effective
- Changes Culture
- Makes HRO Fun
